



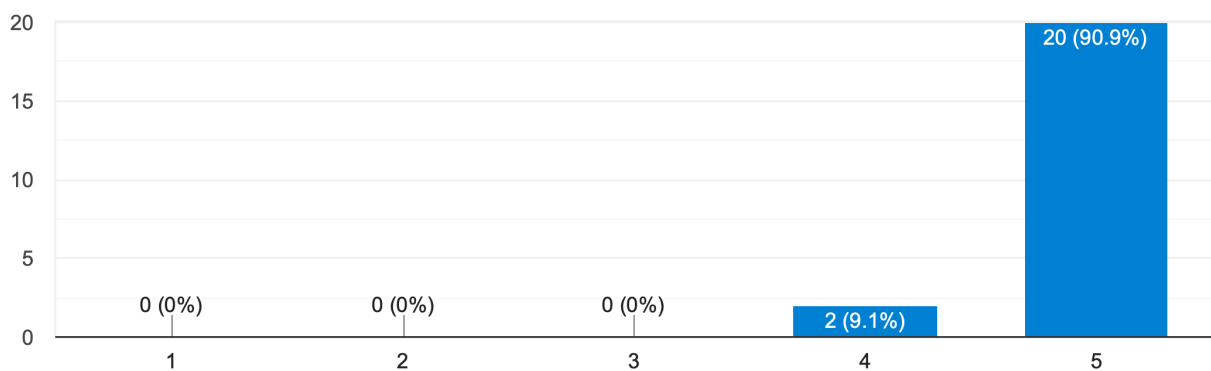

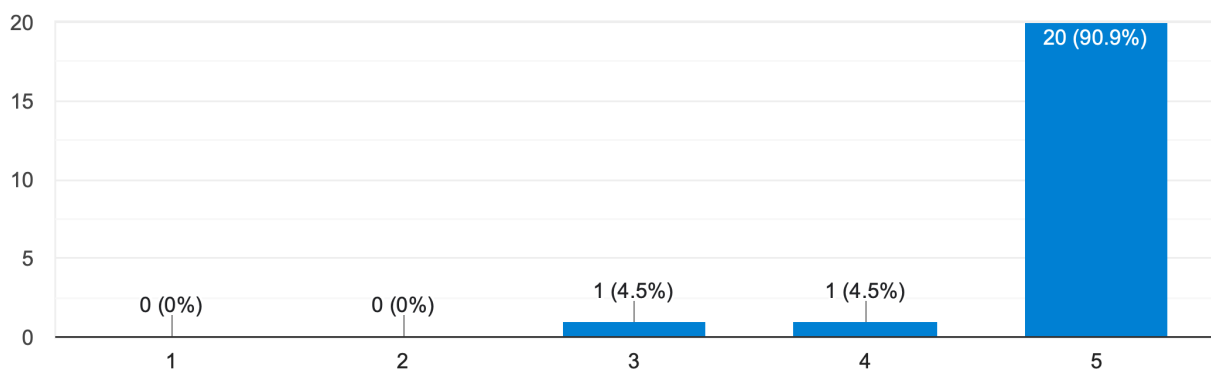


1 = "Not helpful at all"

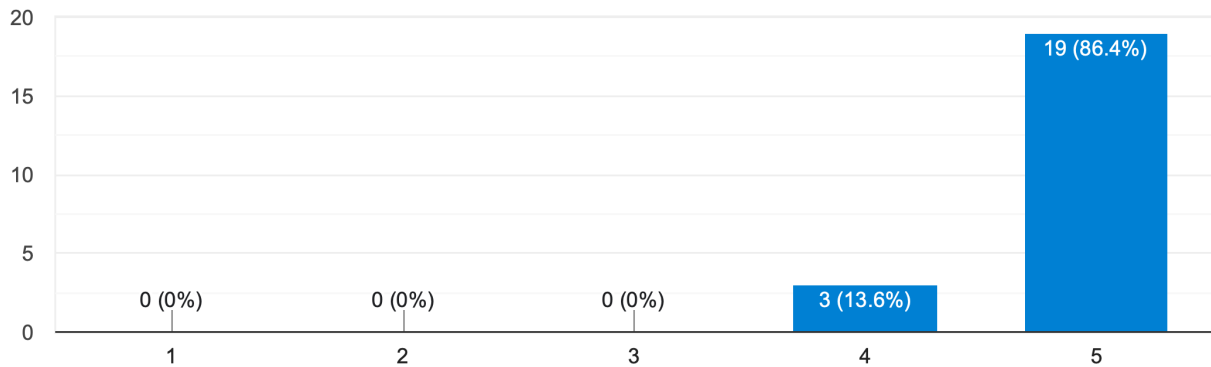


1 = "Not at all"

Even better if:

1. It was mostly your talking, I think maybe more interaction might have been even better?
2. Practice Question drills maybe via eg mentimeter?
3. Most common AKT questions that previous candidates repeatedly get wrong - any extra info on that would be nice.
